EOCCO CAC Charter

Marci: You all should have received a copy of the charter. Jill shared her screen and Marci went over the highlights. The charter is what we use for our map for how to run the CAC. This CAC ensures that the healthcare needs of all the members in our area are being addressed. We will meet every three months. It is open to the public and people can join virtually. OHA provides the rules for the CAC and the members - who can be members, and voting members. The EOCCO CAC selection committee selects the CAC members. The selection committee is looking at the makeup of the CAC. We want it to be diverse and to represent the region. OHP members must make up the majority membership of the CAC. The CAC has to have at least 51% members. It can be OHP members, or the parents or caregivers of OHP members. If a CAC member resigns, we will replace them. We want to fill the seat quickly, within 30 days, but can go as long as 120 days.

Tracey reviewed the terms (3 years). The CAC coordinator is Lourdes, who will schedule meetings. Leadership - Chair and Vice-chair who are elected by a majority vote.

Decision Making

Voting - guests can participate in the meeting but can't vote.

Membership Removal - when we talk about the committee, we are talking about the selection committee.

Sarah Poe: Thank you. This was helpful to understand what our duties are and the scope of our work. For this group, we would be overseeing the development and drafting of a community assessment. She is overseeing this now for the hospital. How much of that burden is on EOCCO staff or this group? Because there are so many other assessments going on, she is hesitant if this group is doing the community health assessment.

Marci: We are required to do one every five years. We don't expect you as members to carry that burden. That is something the staff will do. Though we may reach out to you for contact information.

List of Duties.

Marci: If you hear of a great program in the community we want to hear about it. We might be able to widen it and share with all of EOCCO.

Each year we do a progress report which informs us, the field team does the work on this, but again we may reach out to members.
