
CCO Incentive Measure Program

- ➤ OHA Committee selects measures and targets each year to show how well coordinated care organizations (CCOs):
 - Improve care
 - Make quality care accessible
 - Eliminate health disparities
 - Curb the cost of health care
- Measures can be based on claims, EHR, or chart review data

- CCOs are awarded Quality Pool funds based on annual performance
- > EOCCO uses quality funds for:
 - Quality bonus payments to physical, behavioral, and oral health providers
 - Enhanced PCPCH payments
 - Community Benefit Initiative Reinvestment (CBIR) grants
 - New initiatives, technical assistance, etc.



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Teladoc Diabetes Management Program A whole-person look at diabetes How does it impact the body, and how can it be managed? Change in estimated HbA1c for starting uncontrolled What is diabetes? -1.06% Change in eHbA1c from self-reported HbA1c values for members who started uncontrolled (HbA1c >=7%) and enrolled What parts of the body does diabetes affect? at least 6 months 41% controlled (HbA1c <7%) at baseline How do you manage diabetes? 64% controlled for members enrolled 6M+ Monitor blood sugar Take meds as prescribe
