REPORTS:

Paul: CHP draft, Board approved plan, Kathy moved and Jolene seconded. Reviewed Harney Dashboard of 2018, attached.

Contact Oregon Senior Peer Outreach program, Evelyn to contact and report back at next meeting.

Marci: Applied for grant on 6/7/19 and grant application was approved. The application is for 4,999,000 for Lake, Malheur and Harney counties. Announcement will be made in September or October.

Kathy: Reminder that Social Services Day is June 26th.

On August agenda should vote on Vice Chair for the remainder of the year. Kathy will be gone in September and new person in Kathy's stead will be at the October meeting. He/she will be updated collectively at that meeting.

Chris and Donna: submitted grant for \$244,000 for one year of a therapist and ½ time CHW and mentor. They are committed to finding funding beyond one year. The grant application was accepted and grant will be awarded in July.

Jolene reports that the needle exchange program has been open for 4 days with 300 dirty needles returned and 500 new issued. There has been one HIV test and one Hep C test done.

Kathy to lead meeting in July.

Harney County received biomass grant which is federal and is a source of energy.

Calendars: CHWs and Jolene put together calendar, June is Men's Health month. Suggested to add in April Child Prevention Awareness, September to add know your numbers and possibly have representation at the fair. Move Flu vaccine to October.

We Care Campaign: Jolene went to the Senior Center and Christian Church with the resource list that Deanna made.

Discussed diabetes weigh-in.

Innovation Café: Val talked about food insecurities, trauma, and housing. Jim talked about Clair, the keynote speaker. Evelyn discussed that she will download the Innovation Café's booklet that was given to each attendee, a good source of information and contact people. Also, discussed cost of Café, \$734, which is above our budget of \$520.

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Steve: Discussed the approved on 5/22/19 HCHD Implementation, CHWs to communicate with Steve; develop plan regarding events. Mental Health First Aid, Karen Hunsaker is trainer, also Emily Johnson. See Steve's sheets for some notes, attached.

OTHER: OPEC parent grant awarded for three year commitment.
Frontier Veggie Rx, need referral forms.

Patty: The new application process for LCAC is working well. Discussed inspirational document regarding housing, not just low income. Library focus sessions, June 25th and 27th at the Senior Center from 1-3 pm and at the Central Hotel on 9/11/19 from 1-3 pm.
