EOCCO Updates- Tracey Blood

- 1. Tracey shared Demographic Survey results: 21 respondents. Thank you for completing the survey.
- 2. Community Health Plan (CHP) annual update: There is a workshop following this meeting for anyone that would like to participate to help update the 2019 plan. This is due June 30th back to the state. The workshop results will be sent via email to LCAC

members/guests for comments and approval. LCAC CBIR grant funding is tied to state priorities, and priorities we outline in the CHP. The state set goals/incentive measures. 3. There was a 2021 CBIR grant recipients meeting last week: mapped out distributions, as well as when presentations and reports due. 4. Virtual Conference: April 8 and 9. Andi has sent out the registration link. 5. Kali: No new BOOST trainings or county incentive measure data to report. However, there is a funding opportunity via SHARE for housing. Any interested organization can apply for funds and be considered through the SHARE initiative. To be released first of July, then due to state by end of August. Kali will send out info. And, introduced Kathyrn Hart, who is a new member to the MODA team and does Community Health Worker (CHW/PHW) work. Finance Report from Nancy: Still waiting for last payment to the LCAC for 2020. Have balance for PPE project, and \$937 for Stone Soup project. Will send spreadsheet to Tracy. No 2021 \$ yet, should arrive any day. Then first payments will go out. LCAC operations: Annual Discussion 10k application. Balance right now: \$18,245 dollars. Portion \$2,790 to NDN for support of Andi's work. Then have 15K left. Higher balance this year due to LCAC meetings being remote and not paying for meals or meeting rooms. Consumer Roundtable/Announcements- Kristina Gueli. E2E meeting recap: 1. E2E: Accessibility to dental services remains a priority 2. Stone Soup: Giving plants away, have received dirt. Part of the back area has been tilled. Removed gravel.
