Summary of Actions Taken

• No meeting minutes were approved.

Public Input/Open Comments

- Linda Watson shared a flyer about an online workshop for parents, through Triple P (Positive Parenting Program), that focus on children ages 0-12. Workshop covers shopping with children, bedtime routines, separation anxiety and misbehavior. Parents are eligible for a \$75 gift card upon completion.
- Kathy Fitzpatrick asked for information on CCO 3.0 and where she can give input on the new contract. Marci shared Kris Boler's information for answering questions on CCO 3.0. Linda clarified that CCO 3.0 doesn't start until 2024.

Reports & Updates

Sherman County Medical Clinic Update:

No Sherman County Medical Clinic representatives present at meeting

SHARE Initiative:

Marci shared numbers from Sherman County in 2020 in the chat

- Sherman county Health through Home Weatherization Program applied for \$75,000 to help 10 households in Sherman County who need assistance with poor living conditions.
- Contract should be approved and signed the end of September or beginning of October.

EOCCO Update:

- Courtney shared about the new COVID-19 Vaccine Emergency Tracking Outcome (EOT)
 - 0.5% of 2021 quality pool funds dedicated to EOT
 - For EOCCO this equals approx. \$2 million
 - EOT benchmark= 70% COVID vaccine rate for CCO members who were at least 16 years old as of 1/1/2021
 - CCO-specific improvement targets are based on vaccine rates as of 4/1/2021 as baseline
 - Specifications:
 - Members who receive one dose count as compliant
 - Four-month continuous enrollment criteria
 - Anchor date of 12/31/2021
 - Data source= ALERT IIS
 - Qualifying for payment
 - 90% of EOT funds will be awarded if a CCO achieves the 70% benchmark or CCO specific improvement target for members ages 16+ and for all race/ethnicity groups
 - <u>Partial</u> payment will be given to CCOs who meet the 16+ target and at least 42% vaccination rate for all race/ethnicity groups but not improvement target
 - 10% of EOT funds will be awarded if a CCO achieves the 42% benchmark for members ages 12-15
 - EOCCO is at 27.7% of 16+ vaccinated as of today
 - CCO Improvement Target = ((.70-CCO baseline)*.60)+ CCO
 Baseline
 - Sherman County vaccination numbers have been increasing (59.1% total population unknown about EOCCO members)
 - Patient education is a high need in the area, and needs to be addressed by someone who the local population knows and trusts.
