Become an Oregon Qualified or Certified Health Care Interpreter

What do I need to know about this program?

- Offered to students who are proficient in English and Spanish (students must pass a proficiency test to enroll)
- Prepares students for interpreting in health care settings
- 8 weeks/64 hours of training
- 3 in-person days are required
- Will prepare you to apply to become an Oregon Qualified or Certified Interpreter
- This course is taught by OSU.
 Students will need to use the Canvas online platform to view assignments and grades.
