2025 THW Legislative Updates

Oregon's 2025 Regular Legislative Session is in full swing, and there's a handful of THW-related bills preparing to be introduced and voted on. This includes:

- All THWs: SB 161, SB 529, SB 695
- CHWs: HB 2216, HB 2751
- Doulas: SB 690 (momnibus), SB 692, SB 693, SB 691 & SB 695
- Peers: HB 2954, SB 691
