



## Data flow to support care gap closure

EHR Data refreshed nightly and supplemented with monthly claims & eligibility loads Data matched & processed; risk scores and quality metrics calculated nightly to ensure freshest information


## **VISIBILITY INTO EVENTS OUTSIDE YOUR CLINIC**

ED visits, hospitalization, and events from non clinically-integrated EOCCO clinics have been loaded and are available for analysis



## A MORE COMPLETE VIEW OF QUALITY MEASURES

If a provider down the street closes a quality gap for one of your patients and submits a claim to MODA, it will be reflected in your measure performance in Arcadia.



## A MORE ROBUST VIEW OF EACH PATIENT

More robust Utilization History, including insight into Significant Events, available to providers, care managers, and outreach coordinators

# TYPES OF ATTRIBUTION

## CLINICAL

The PCP that the patient is assigned to in the EHR 1 patient : 1 provider (per EHR)

## RENDERING

The physicians who have seen this patient in the specified lookback period

1 patient : many providers



### **PLAN**

The PCP that MODA has assigned for the member 1 patient : 1 provider

## **FUNCTIONAL**

Arcadia's best inference for which provider is primarily responsible if other methods are mis-aligned 1 patient: 1 provider

## **CCO MEASURE VARIATIONS**

### CCO 2018 'OHA SPEC' MEASURES

#### **DATA USED**

Per the OHA spec, this is set on a measure by measure basis.

#### WHY

These measures are used by Moda to capture the final performance – after claims lag runs out – for State submission.

### CCO 2018 'HYBRID' MEASURES

#### **DATA USED**

Arcadia considers claims and clinical data for all measures – even where the OHA spec does not allow this – to provide more complete and timely information on measure performance.

#### WHY

These measures are recommended for operational workflows, where the clinical evidence of gap closure helps ensure you're engaging patients who really haven't had care – not those who were seen recently.

The standard OHA spec set shows true performance, while the Hybrid set considers claims and clinical data sources for more complete and timely insights.
