Incentive Metric Update – Amanda Grove

- The data provide is from January 20, 2018 to June 20, 2018
- Is there comparative data from last year to see if we are on track? Yes and no, the reporting periods vary from year to year. Jill are Amanda are willing to find some of last year's data and compare it this year's numbers in October.
- Each incentive metric's goal will increase by 3% each year until we meet the state claims data requirement.
- The 8 measures presented are measured all along and the other 10 will be presented at the end of the year.
- The data provided is only measuring the Medicaid population.
- In the future we need to have a discussion about child hood immunizations and our county. The LCAC is the place to begin making change in this area.
