### **Grant Health Department –**

Community Health Assessment – Kathy Cancilla

Currently doing community outreach, will visit each town in Grant County. The survey that has

been sent out will collect demographics and perception data. The Community Health Assessment (CHA) is done once every five years. Info collected so far: When Monument lost ambulance service it was a huge impact and very isolating, it has since been returned. Kathy will share data collected with the group when they are done with the assessment.

**Grant County Community Health Improvement Plan –Linda Watson**

- We met all 17 metrics as an EOCCO last time around, will be receiving more money next year.
- Set a timeline, get the CHIP plan done in time for grant deadline, revise plan and application schedule (September?)
- Possibly have one focus metric- % of money going to community improvement projects and % of money going to meet metrics.
