<p>DISCUSSION</p>	<p>Incentive Measure Progress Report:</p> <p>Amanda passed out the incentive measure report , final numbers have not be reported. Adolescent Well Care visits have increased, we should be close to hitting that measure. SBIRT was just monitored this year, but will start counting in 2019.</p> <p>RCAC Update – Amanda</p> <p>Amanda attended last week’s RCAC meeting in The Dalles. The RCAC works on our Regional Community Health Plan. They are required this year to be working towards at least two of the goals in the state health plan, so projects are in line. RCAC chose to focus on ACE’s/trauma informed care and food security. The EOCCO is working on the CCO 2.0 application, and reviewed it’s focus on community engagement projects: housing support, expanding tele-health, expand access to naloxone, imbedding CHW in ED’s, pain school. The EOCCO is trying to move towards more continuity with the LCAC Agenda Calendar to support coordinators and chairs in agenda planning, Amanda will email out the LCAC calendar. Food security was also on the list of items to be potentially addressed via 2.0. Three counties are already doing veggie rx programs. New Directions is working to get tele-med, known as Mend, in outer lying cities in the county, for access to a provider.</p> <p>CBIR Funding Updates – Amanda</p> <p>Application has been approved with one contingency. Contingency was based upon the billing process from the ages and stages questionnaire. Amanda is working with head start to resolve this issue. A big congrats on this!</p>
