Paul (by phone) discussed three applications from 2017 of Gilliam's unused money: diabetes, colorectal cancer, adolescent well child checks: and Jolene's carryover. The \$5000 veggie Rx and \$6100 for Slater garden were not approved but subcommittee will meet again on the 22<sup>nd</sup> and chances are they will be approved. Discussed CCO 2.0 developing now and extending one year. 2.2 billion dollars were saved. Rural Rx opioids have shown a great decrease in EOCCOs. There is access to Pain School.

Reviewed incentive measures – contraceptive measure should have a green line.

EOCCO CHP: the hospital is due for update 6/19. Public Health, Symmetry and Early Childhood Development agree on year cycle. Harney to work on the issue. First focus to be qualitative portion then quantitative.
