The information from the focus group will help EOCCO with the community health plan and the assessment will also include qualitative data.

- Focus group will help with the qualitative portion of the Community Health Assessment. Every 5 years the Oregon Health Authority requires a new Community Health Assessment, next one is due June 2019. The qualitative portion has begun and during the fall the data will be provided to the Community Advisory Councils. In the spring, new plans will be formulated.
