



Minutes
Malheur County Community Advisory Council Meeting
Eastern Oregon Coordinated Care Organization
Tuesday, June 19th, 2018, 12:00 – 1:30 pm
Lifeways, Ontario



1. **Call to Order, Introductions, & Dinamica** – Megan Gomeza, Chair- welcomed the group and called the meeting to order. Megan –Started the group with a dinamica, and Andrea Recla, Secretary, took notes for minutes.
2. **Approval of Past Month's Minutes** - Minutes from the April meeting was approved by consensus without changes. Andrea Recla took notes.
3. **Open Discussion - Karina** from VFHC discussed concerns about the process for getting OHP members switched from Advantage Dental to Oregon Dental Services (ODS), stating that there has been a trend lately with multiple denials and it requires multiple attempts to get an OHP member switched. Paul McGuinnis, representative of GOBHI, and Jessica Steele of Advantage Dental agreed to investigate the matter and report back. Lindsay Grosvener of VFHC inquired about fee for service for her work as a dietician, including what services are covered and requirement for payment through Oregon Health Plan. Paul McGuinnis agreed to follow-up and offered Summer Prantl (contact information to be shared by Megan) as a contact.
4. **EOCCO Incentive Measure Updates** – Paul McGinnis, GOBHI
Paul presented data on projected 2018 incentive measure for the EOCCO and Malheur County. Highlights include that Malheur County is currently on track to meet incentive measures for ED Utilization and Adolescent Well Care visits. Paul addressed questions about what the incentive measures mean for EOCCO providers as well as items to be address in the CCO 2.0 model. Maria Vargas invited CAC members to attend the CCO 2.0 meeting that evening 6/19 at TVCC from 6:30 pm – 8 pm. Requests for Severe and Persistent Mentally Ill (SPMI) populations was requested for the August CAC meeting.
5. **Spring Into Wellness (SIW)** – Karina Carbajal; Megan Gomeza
 - Reports briefly that the final Spring into wellness fair in Vale, Oregon was completed last Friday (6/15) and that there were 7 fairs in total with over 40 vendors and over 1,000 community members reached. More to come at next meeting.
6. **2018 Community Food Assessment** – Lynn Knox, Oregon Food Bank
Presented a slideshow discussing the March 2018 Malheur County Community Food Assessment conducted by the EOCCO an Oregon Food Bank (OFB). Highlights include a low SNAP use (food stamps), high poverty rate, with most of food retailers being in Malheur Counties "urban areas" including Ontario, Nyssa, and Vale, with the rest of the county being approximately 20 miles away from nearest food retailer. Malheur County includes 6 pantries, 2 mobile deliveries, 4 produce distributions, 1 meal site, and 3 school panties. Peter Lawson of OFB agreed to share updated information about pantry location and times with the Community Advisory Council to share with its members. Some recommendations for improvement include increased transportation assistance, improve food assistance mobile capability, increase home/community gardening, and increase in referrals for food resources among various health care providers.

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7. Nutrition Oregon Campaign – Monica Cuneo, Moore Institute

Presented a Ted Talks video about nutrition and how maternal nutrition while pregnant can impact the child and future grandchildren's health. This is considered the 2-generation nutritional effect. In addition, babies born with a low birth-rate or high birth-rate are at higher risk for chronic illness/disease and are more likely to die earlier than those born at a normal birth weight. Epigenetics were discussed. Due to time limitations Monica had to leave but agreed to finish presentation at a future CAC meeting.

8. Healthy Living Alliance & Four Rivers Health Care – Luke Owens, Stark Medical

Due to time limitations, Luke encouraged members to read the Eastern Oregon healthy Living Alliance bulletin provided for more information and agreed to present at the next CAC meeting.
