	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Gym Memberships: 22 memberships at each of the 3 clinics (Winding Waters, MVMG and Olive Branch); working well with gyms; Malia has been doing lots of heavy lifting on this project; working with Motivations and The Vault-invoice process just started Rooted Youth: Invoice received and submitted (\$2,000) Healthcare Shares: CSA boxes have been purchased and looking into options for a farmer's market share; cooking classes are starting to happen with Emily Sheehan Car Seat Training (CPST): Three trainers have completed CPST training; approval to start purchasing car seats and working on workflow with clinics for distribution. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> May need other supplies for installation assistance (ex: pool noodles, towels) Lactation Consultation: Discussion about support for lactation consultation, do we want to support certification process, support groups (La Leche) and/or FTE for more availability? <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Nora Hawkins (midwife) may be primary contact for establishing a support group for new mothers around breastfeeding (among other topics) May need additional funding to support this project (consider reaching out to Blue Mountain Hospital for matching funds; Circle 100) Project may also include adjusting take home bags that are meaningful/meet the needs for new moms (less formula, nipple cream) Process for payment: Need invoice for payment expended (letterhead preferred); Email to Meg, Jill or Autumn for approval; Marilyn will cut checks and give to Meg/Autumn for delivery
