Amanda - Incentive Measure's Progress Report:

We are currently meeting two measures: ED utilization and DHS custody incentive measure. Don't know if health department has submitted data from the adolescent event.

CBIR 2019/2020 funding updates:

We have received the 2nd payment and it has been distributed for: Health Fair, to Community Connections for housing, to IMESD for first aid classes (up to 5 free CPR and first aid classes), and money for the New Year's eve party for youth. Two things left: E2E \$300 and \$ for Fiscal Agent in April or May. 2nd payment for challenge day was also made. Challenge day is Dec 9 and 10. Focus is middle school students. Contact Haley if you would like to help.

CBIR 2020/2021 applications: Draft has been released to staff. Hopefully this week the final application will be released. Requirements this year: Not required to target incentive measures with LCAC funds, yet do have to focus on social determinants of health and community health plan components. Process: Same request for 1 page proposals, whole LCAC approve and review. If open to subcommittee to allow more time to review. Review in November. And Dec. then submit Jan. And yes, those that were not in attendance at today's meeting will get notified. We will send out an email with a formal announcement.

Recommendation: Amanda can send email to whole CAC and get people to sign up to be on a subcommittee for application reviews. One rep from each sector/service area (i.e. hospital, community connections, early learning, E2E, and all programs). The total award is more than last year. Total is \$59,326. Would like applicants to present projects in first meeting, and review in separate meeting.

Consensus to go with this recommendation. Goal is for subcommittee to get together in November and December. Amanda will send out info today or tomorrow. Application deadline will be November 8th, then subcommittee with meet later in Nov. and Dec. Applicants will invited to first subcommittee meeting and decisions will be made at the 2nd meeting.

CHP (or CHIP?) review in March or April. Spring update for following year.

Other grants: Are geared toward primary care providers and public health.

EOCCO public meeting – Nov. 5, 12-2. At OTEC. Intro – where we have been

and where we are headed, focus on areas for change. LCAC will present on some of the projects from grants. Haley and Alisha will be presenting. Trial of presentation was made last week at the regional CAC. Good feedback. To help with format of Nov. Structure: things that have to be covered. Space for things LCAC wants covered: access and availability; dental discussion – only one provider locally. Going to ask for help getting the flier out and word out. English and Spanish. Recruit health plan members. Technically, this is an Insurance company coming to town to ask how they are doing. Would like support on the event day from CAC members to help with logistics. Sign ins, etc. Have to document everything. Comments have to be captured verbatim. Multiple note takers and audio record.

We are in the middle of getting approved by the state to provide services in EO, if we can provide services out here, and state said yes. Presentation then open discussion.
